To M. Payne Clerk and Master of the Chancery Court at Greenville.

Whereas William K. Love, James T. Love, and Preston A. Love, of the firm of Wm. K. Love & Brothers hath filed in the Chancery Court at Sevierville their Bill of complaint, representing among other things that, they heretofore sold to one Micajah C. Rogers their Furnace in Sevier County, in part consideration whereof the said Rogers agreed to furnish them with a large quantity of merchantable pig Iron annually for the term of eight years- for a failure on the part of the said Rogers to furnish the stipulated quantity of Pig Iron for the first year of the said eight years, the said Loves have by their suit heretofore in the Circuit Court for the County of Sevier recovered against the said Rogers the sum of six thousand dollars- and that a certain, David Shields, (now deceased) Milton Shields, Samuel Shields, Andrew Smith, John Guthrie, John Rice & perhaps others, now conducting the Business at said Furnace (now called Sweden Furnace) under the firm & name of Shields Smith & Co, heretofore, but subsequent, to the sale of said Furnace by said Loves to said Rogers, entered into a partnership concerning the management of said Furnace business, with said Rogers- and knowingly adopted said ~~Rogers~~ business, with said Rogers, and ~~knowing-~~ ~~ly~~ ~~adopted~~ contract of said Rogers, with said Loves concerning Pig metal to be furnished said Loves, by said Rogers, at said Furnace.- and that a decree has been entered in Greenville state of Tennessee- the object of which is to close the concerns of said firm; and to do so that a sale of said Furnace property shall be had by the Clerk and Master; of said property, on the 16th day of this Instant (month September, 1840) at the premises in Sevier County- on the proceedings had in the Court at Greenville-

You the said M. Payne Clerk & Master of as aforesaid; are hereby notified that the Hon. Robt. M. Anderson Judge of the 12th Judicial circuit of Tennessee commanding an injunction to issue, staying & injoining the sale of said Furnace property, and all lands sold by said Loves to said Rogers-

You the said M. Payne clerk & master as aforesaid- and the said Micajah C. Rogers, Milton Shields, Samuel Shields, John Guthrie, John Rice and all others your counsellars, aiders, and abettors are hereby commanded to stop & stay & altogether superseded all further proceeding in and about said sale of said property; until the further order of this Honorable Court. And this injunction you shall in no wise disregard under the penalty of an attachment for contempt.
