.....The only Lovelady in our family was the wife of Jackson Butts, who married a Lovelady first. Two sons died during Civil War. Daughter Margaret Ann Butts married Moses Cooley and moved to Wayne County, Miss. They lived in Victoria, Texas, in September 1848 and Jackson Butts married again -----

She quotes--From Mrs. D. Y. Baldwin, Box 481, Tomball, Texas, She said her father was John Lovelady Born St. Joseph, Mo., in 1862. His father was John also, born Lafayette, Tenn., about 1828. His father also was John, died in Tennessee, born probably in S.C. or Va. She said her grandfather's father was probably the son of THOMAS LOVELADY.

In an old letter written in 1848 from Joseph Baker and Elender Butts his wife to Jackson Butts he said give our respects to Joseph Lovelady and family, so you see there had to be another family living in Victoria, Texas, then. Probably the parents of Jackson Butt's wife.

Another letter said the name Lovelady was one time spelled Lovelatty. The Butts family came from Holland to S.C. to Tenn, to Mo. and later Jackson Butts to Texas.

Mrs. J.Y. Baldwin, Box 873, Anahue, Texas, wrote Jan. 12 1944 My great-grandfather James Lovelady born 1816 m. Eurith Elizabeth Lewis born 1818. (Joe, dd you have any Lewis data?) Children Mary B. 1845 m. Mr. Wright. Georgean Elizabeth b. 1816 (??) m. Henson. Other, Williams b. 1838 d. 1862.
