Do you have the military service record of Peter Rambo? He died in this County (Sevier) about 1841 or 1842. He is said to have been a "soldier and a spy" under General William Hull when Detroit was surrendered to the British, August, 1812, and was imprisoned in Canada for over a year. He was probably living in Virginia at the time of the War of 1812. The earliest record I have of him here is in the 1820's.
