We find that we do not have either a muster roll or a payroll for Capt. Wilson Maples' Company, 5th Regiment (Booth's) East Tennessee Militia, War of 1812. Captain Maples resigned his commission on December 22, 1814, and was succeeded by Capt. John Porter.

We have a muster roll and a payroll for Capt. John Porter's Company covering the period November 14, 1814-May 18, 1815. Captain Maples' name appears on these two rolls. If you are interested in having photostats of these two rolls, they can be furnished for \$8. Please allow several weeks for processing an order as the rolls are in such condition that they cannot be reproduced until after they have undergone extensive repairs.
