There were no bridges, only footlogs or swinging bridges for the walking traffic. High waters often prevented your crossing and stopped all traffic, whether horse-drawn or cars. As you crossed the stream, in the water, you kept your fingers crossed for fear the car would get stalled, because of rocks, sand, or too deep water, and you would have to wade out and go for help.

Dr. J. W. Bradshaw, one of the fine young men who came to Emerts Cove in the early years to marry a local girl. This young lady being Ellen Emert. Ellen was the daughter of F. L. and Michael Emert. The chapter "Those Who Served" tells in detail about Dr. Bradshaw's education and background. In an Oblituary in his memory, written by Hills Creek Baptist Church, it was noted that he was an active member of his church as well as ministering to the sick. It stated; "the rich and the poor" were equal in his sympathy and treatment. Everyone got the same kind of care, regardless of whether they could pay or not. These words quoted from the Bible they thought fitting to his memory: "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever." This document was written and signed by John P. Price, John H. Lethco, and S.S. Proffitt.


